Beaconsfield State School will receive**

\$117,080*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the average attendance rate from 91.6% to 92.7% for all students.
- Maintain the percentage of students receiving an A-C in English, Mathematics and Science at above 80%.
- Every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.

Our initiatives include

- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation.
- Develop a shared understanding of 'data literacy' and support teachers and leadership teams to effectively use data to inform targeted teaching.
- Develop teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle.
- Develop teachers' capability to design and deliver age-appropriate highly individualised curriculum plans to students using the general capabilities of the Australian Curriculum.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Use Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress.
- Develop or adapt an oral language program for use in Prep and Year 1.
- Provide TRS to enable triads of teachers/leaders to engage in collaborative data inquiry, action learning, classroom visits and professional conversations.
- Allocate TRS to support year level moderation and cross-year moderation working groups once a term.
