## This funding will be used to


- Ensure all students in Years 3 and 5 in 2015 achieve Numeracy and Literacy results at or above National Minimum Standard OR have in place an Individual Learning Guarantee (ILP) that outlines strategies and support to address this.
- Enhance staff capability through improved data analysis and differentiated learning while focusing on enhanced Pedagogy particularly in developing student writing skills.
- Achieve Year 3 NAPLAN School Mean in Spelling of 410 with 43% of students achieving at or above Upper Two Band scores.
- Achieve Year 3 NAPLAN School Mean in Writing of 420 with 55% of students achieving at or above Upper Two Band scores.
- Every student who is accessing a different year level curriculum (that is an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard.

## Our strategy will be to

- Enhance further our cycle of data collection with analysis of individual progress at five weekly intervals with targeted intervention of identified at-risk students in Prep to Year 3.
- Utilise internal monitoring data to inform differentiated learning plans in Maths, Reading, Writing and Spelling to set and monitor accurate learning goals and strategies to improve student performance.
- Develop a recognition system that tracks, encourages and celebrates classes and individuals who achieve 95% attendance or better each term.
- Embed the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice.
- Provide education for parents of Pre-Prep students to support oral language development and early literacy and numeracy skills at home

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employ five additional teacher aides to support targeted programs for literacy and numeracy improvement in the P-3 year levels - \$60000
- Allocating funds towards professional development, targeting teacher capability with data analysis, goal setting, differentiation, writing, spelling and collegial coaching - \$ 11600
- Purchasing resources that support and engage student learning, support teachers with data collection and analysis - \$3000
- Coordinating Parent engagement and training opportunities focusing on developing student literacy and numeracy skills - \$5000
- Funding incentive awards to celebrate successful class and individual student attendance rates as well as providing human resources support to families not achieving our attendance goal - \$2050
