Under this agreement for 2020 Beaconsfield State School will receive

\$173,318*

This funding will be used to

- Improve the attendance of Indigenous students from 86.6% in 2019 to 88.6% in 2020.
- Ensure that every student accessing a different year level curriculum (that is, with an Individual Curriculum Plan) will achieve a 'C' standard or better against the relevant year-level achievement standard. Ensure these align with your School Strategic Plan and Annual Implementation Plan.
- Improving teacher skills and knowledge of the power of feedback

Our initiatives include

- Implementing whole school collection of reading data to inform reading instruction and teacher decision making, and monitor student progress and achievement Implementing Universal Design for Learning (UDL) as an approach to create connected and engaged learners, improving student wellbeing and academic achievement supported by an inclusion coach at the point of need for teachers and students
- Supporting the capability development of our staff through differentiated observation, feedback and coaching processes for beginning, early career and experienced educators
- Using the Literacy Continuum to measure progress and development of students.
- Using Early Start materials across Prep to Year 2 to inform teaching, learning and resourcing, and to track progress.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employment of a staff member to mentor and support the attendance, retention and achievement of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students (\$45,600)
- Developing a plan for monitoring early phase literacy and numeracy, including the schedule of Early Start assessments, and opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention (\$45,600)
- Developing a whole school approach to teaching reading to support the teaching of reading across all learning areas (\$22,800)
- Developing teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle (\$29,659)
- Providing teacher release time to collaborate and moderate with staff using Literacy Continuum (\$29,659)
