## This funding will be used to

- Deepen staff member knowledge of all aspects of the Australian Curriculum, including general capabilities and cross-curriculum priorities, to ensure a shared understanding and consistent delivery of the school's curriculum expectations.
- Provide enhanced maintenance of school infrastructure and facilities to provide students with greater learning opportunities.
- Provide targeted support to Tier 2 and 3 students.

## Our initiatives include

- Support for teaching staff to align teaching content to the Australian Curriculum.
- Support for new and beginning teachers to further understand and embed teaching pedagogical practices.
- Development of the ICT knowledge and skills of students and staff, and the increased provision of ICT devices and infrastructure to support student engagement and learning.
- Support for Tier 2 and 3 students through increased program delivery to support individual social, emotional and learning needs.

• Employing a Head of Department (Curriculum) to support curriculum implementation	\$ 124,001
• Employing extra staffing to support beginning teachers	\$ 33,880
• Purchasing additional ICT equipment to support learning activities	\$ 21,000
• Purchasing additional teacher aide time to support and engage Tier 2 and 3 students	\$ <u>10,646</u>
